

Embrun Co-op Scholarship for Post-Secondary Studies

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

- Offers Embrun Co-op employees the opportunity to receive a scholarship to help cover post-secondary education costs.
- Three awards will be granted: \$1000, \$750, and \$500.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible, the applicant must:

- Have earned an Ontario Secondary School Diploma and be enrolled in a post-secondary program.
- Be pursuing studies related to one of Embrun Co-op's areas of activity: administration, agriculture, retail, or energy.
- Have been employed by Co-op for at least 90 cumulative days at the time of application.
- Work an average of 15 hours per week or more.
- Commit to being present in mid-August to receive the award at Co-op BBQ.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Interested applicants must submit:

- A completed application form.
- A letter answering the question:

"What knowledge or experiences have you gained while working at the Co-op that you will continue to use in the future?"

Embrun Co-op and Board of Directors will determine which applications best meet the selection criteria.


